The 2011 Cotes du Roussillon Villages Les Orris is a total jaw dropper and I was stunned after tasting it. Deep purple in color, it offers up incredible notes of plum, kirsch, licorice and mineral that continue to develop and change in the glass. A blend of 70% Grenache, 25% Syrah and 5% Mourvedre that spent 12 months in barrel, this full-bodied, seamlessly textured and elegant 2011 has superb richness and depth, yet never seems heavy in the least. It's a brilliant bottle of wine that will evolve gracefully for over a decade.

Made by Jean Boucabeille, these are all superb wines that have a fantastic mix of richness and elegance. I was blown away by them.

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
