Looking first at his white, the 2011 Cotes du Roussillon Les Orris Blanc is an interesting blend of 60% Maccabeu, 30% Grenache Blanc and 10% Roussanne that's aged all in barrique. Light gold in color, with notions of Asian pear, white peach and distinct minerality, it flows onto the palate with a medium-bodied, fresh, lively feel that carries gorgeous purity and excellent length. It will pair beautifully with food, and drink nicely for 2-3 years, if not longer.

Made by Jean Boucabeille, these are all superb wines that have a fantastic mix of richness and elegance. I was blown away by them.

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
